First Sunday of Advent Keep awake! Be Ready! (Based on Matthew 24:36-44)

L: The Son of Man is coming but about that day and hour no one knows P: Neither the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.

L: Keep awake therefore, for you do not know on what day your Lord is coming.

P: Therefore, be ready for the Son of Man is coming at an unexpected hour.

L: We light the first candle of Advent to remind us to keep awake and be ready.






