Fellowship Hall Cleaning up Procedure

- 1. Wipe and sanitize all tables
- 2. Wipe and sanitize all chairs
- 3. Place all chairs on tables (one chair standing and other flipped upside down//bottom to bottom) 4 to a table
- 4. Sweep and mop floor (cleaning supplies are under sink cabinet)
- 5. Take all trash out of the restroom and kitchen and place it in the trash can outside.
- 6. Put new trash bags in cans. They are under the microwave cabinet.
- 7. Clean Rest Rooms
- 8. Sweep and mop restrooms and hallway to Fellowship Hall
- 9. Clean glass doors.
- 10. The nursery is to be cleaned (Spray everything down with Lysol)
- 11. Notify the Field Sanitation Team (FST) about your event to ensure they are about to spray.
 - > Do NOT put nails or tub tacks in walls!
 - Do NOT put tape on walls!
 - If you hang streamer or anything from the ceiling with thumbtacks, please ensure you remove tacks and all traces of debris from the ceiling.
 - > You may put extra chairs and tables you don't want to use in Fellowship Storage.
 - You are responsible to set Fellowship Hall back up as normal. (Unless otherwise informed by Pastor)

Sanctuary Cleaning up Procedure

- 1. Vacuum entire church, between and under all pews
- 2. Ensure there is no trash in songbook holders
- 3. Clean Rest Rooms
- 4. Put new trash bags in cans in Rest Rooms (bags are in marked cabinets)
- 5. Sweep and mop the hallway, restrooms, and foyer.
- 6. Clean glass doors.
- 7. Sound Room is to be cleaned
- 8. The nursery is to be cleaned
- 9. Spray everything down with Lysol
- 10. Notify the Field Sanitation Team (FST) about your event to ensure they are about to spray

- > Do NOT put tape, nails, or thumbtacks anywhere in Sanctuary.
- Do NOT move any furniture without Pastor's Permission.
- > Above ^ This includes sound equipment.
- > No one is to be up in the Sound Room without first meeting with the Pastor.

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
