5. What is Peter's response to these instructions in 10:14? Why do you think Peter responds in this way?

6. Why do you think God did this three times in Acts 10:16?

7. Why do you think the Holy Spirit has to help Peter understand what is going on in Acts 10:17-19?

8. In Acts 10:23 Peter has two responses to the Gentiles. What are these two responses? How do they show that Peter is following (perhaps slowly) God's will?
