The Second Sunday of Advent focus shifts to FAITH with the Bethlehem Candle, reminding us of Mary and Joseph's journey to the city where Jesus would be born. The Third Sunday of Advent which is also referred to as "Gaudete Sunday," The vestment will be rose-colored one at this Sunday's Mass and rose is also the color of the Shepherd's Candle. Both symbolize the world's JOY for the long-expected savior's birth.
