Would you like to donate a flower arrangement for the altar one Sunday in 2022? You may donate the arrangement in honor or memory of a loved one or celebrate a special occasion. Cost is \$25 and may be donated online or placed in the offering plate. Just look for the Flower Notebook on the table in the empty space to the right of the chancel to sign up. Dates are available January -June.

WEBSITE/ONLINE GIVING UPDATE

We have been working on our new website. Have you checked it out???? This is where you can enter a prayer request, see the church calendar, and more!

It is quite different from the past and we ask that you bear with us as we learn how best to utilize this web tool (which is free for our use!). Many of you will be happy to know that the Online Giving within this tool is fully functional! You can now use your bank account, a credit/debit card, or text message for your weekly/monthly offerings.

Some important items to know:

- You will need to create an account at: <u>Epiphany Lutheran Church (churchtrac.com)</u> (https://epiphanypns.churchtrac.com). Creating an account is for your protection and helps prevent fraud should you choose to give online.
- If you use the email that we have on file for you, most of your information will be automatically added to your account. You can also take this opportunity to update any personal information for you and/or your immediate family members.
- Click on the large green box on the home page to set up online giving.
 - o There are 3 headers across the top of the page Credit/Debit, ACH/Checking and SMS/Text
 - O You can schedule a one-time offering or set up a recurring offering. Be aware that automatic offerings begin on the date you enter the information and then at the frequency you set. So, if it is the 12th of the month and you set up a monthly offering, they will all be on the 12th. To change this, you'll need to delete and re-schedule your automatic giving.
 - o If you use your bank account, you'll need to verify two small deposits that will appear in your account in about 2 days. Once you have those deposits, log back in and go to online giving to enter the number of pennies that you received. After confirming the amounts you'll be able to set up your giving amount and frequency.
 - You have the option to add a memo to your gift for instance if you are giving to the general fund but it is for your flower sponsorship you can add "Flower Sponsor" as a memo.
 - o If you wish to also give to a restricted fund, you have the option to add another fund and then choose from the drop-down list for these funds: Building, Memorial, Pastor's Discretionary, or WNALC.

You have the option to cover the processing fee for your credit/debit card giving. If you choose yes, the software will automatically increase your offering to cover the cost.

You can have multiple offering frequencies and store more than one credit/debit card. You might want to give weekly to the General Fund and once a month to the Building Fund.
