

## Children's Church Lesson: Moses in the Basket

- **Bible Story:** Exodus 2:1-10
  - **Key Verse:** "God had a plan for baby Moses." (Exodus 2:10)
  - **Lesson Focus:** God protected baby Moses.
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### Lesson Plan

1. **Welcome and Opening Prayer:**
  - Begin with a short prayer asking God to help the children understand how He protected Moses and how He protects them too.
2. **Bible Story** (Exodus 2:1-10):
  - Tell the story of baby Moses being hidden in a basket by his mother to keep him safe. Highlight how God had a plan to protect Moses, even when things seemed dangerous.
  - Use simple language for younger children, emphasizing the key points: God kept baby Moses safe by guiding his mother to place him in a basket on the river, and how Pharaoh's daughter found and cared for him.
3. **Key Verse:**
  - Practice saying the key verse together: "God had a plan for baby Moses." (Exodus 2:10)
  - Help the children understand that just like God had a plan for Moses, He has a plan for their lives too.
4. **Discussion:**
  - Ask the children:
    - Who kept baby Moses safe?
    - What did Moses' mother do to protect him?
    - How did God show His love for Moses?
    - How does God protect us today?

### Closing:

- Remind the children of the key verse: "God had a plan for baby Moses." (Exodus 2:10) and how God's plan is always good, even when things are difficult.
- Close with a prayer thanking God for His protection over Moses and for watching over each of the children.

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
