



King Jesus is not a king like typical kings.

King Jesus does not reign by force or violence. During his earthly reign, he raised no army. His government is not a manipulative chain of power where those above oppressively lord their authority over those bellow, and those bellow snivelingly ingratiate themselves to those above. Citizens in his kingdom are not the bottom rung of a vast power scheme, easily forgotten, used for their economic value or conscripted for their military usefulness. Sadly, these flaws show up in human government, but none of them describe how Jesus rules.

But he does rule. Jesus reigns as King in the lives of his people. It just isn't like typical human kings.

Instead of ruling over us as a tyrant and turning us into tyrants over each other, Jesus rules as a servant. The average citizen - the forgotten, ignored, abused, oppressed, or used by the kings of this earth - is important to him, and he establishes a friendship with each one of us. He rejects the practice of chasing after airs and trying to be seen as important, or at the top, but calls us away from it all.

Jesus reigns in our lives by discipleship - by teaching and instructing his people to live a particular, peculiar way of life. He calls us to downward mobility, embracing a servants post, living to forward not merely our own interests but the interests of others.

If we are going to live this way, then it isn't just that King Jesus is going to be a different kind of king. We've got to be a different kind of citizenry. Jesus must lift up our hearts out of the world, and lead us into a very different way of life. We've got to learn to obey - to trust the Spirit to help us and lean into obedience to Jesus's very different way.

And that's how he reigns. Jesus woos us by his love and by his cross, so that we will want to become his citizens. He naturalizes us into his church and his kingdom, so that we can live as his citizens. He trains us to trust the Spirit he gives us, and to obey the teachings and commandments he has given us. Through all of this, we become very different people that what we would be if we had never met him. All of this is called discipleship.

This is what Jesus trained twelve men to do. He led them to understand his ways, and he taught them to trust his Spirit. But it wasn't really about them, or at least it was never designed to end with them. It was about Jesus becoming the ruler of the universe, the one who would reign over men's souls and lives, leading them to God, his Father. He sent them out into the world so that they would help people to make him the king of their lives.

But King Jesus isn't a king like other kings. He doesn't rule through force or compulsion. He rules through discipleship and through love.
