Virginia Creeper Bike Trail Trip

Saturday, July 20th

The Virginia Creeper Trail is a multi-use trail located in south-west Virginia, along an old railroad bed. It's a packed gravel surface through woodland, along a river and crossing multiple old rail trestles. The section we will ride is a gentle downhill section that's 17 miles from Whitetop to Damascus VA.

Key Points

- Open to all ages that feel they're capable of riding a bike over uneven surfaces for 17 miles.
- Children 12 & under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- You do NOT need your own bicycle. We will be using an outfitter to rent bikes and be shuttled to the start of the ride.
 - ⇒ You can bring your own bicycle if you like and pay a reduced rate for just the shuttle service.
 - ⇒ Note that EV Bikes, or motorized bikes are not allowed on the trail.
 - ⇒ They do have pull behind buggies for small children as well if you wish to use that option.

- We will carpool from the church building to Damascus, VA. It will be an all-day event. We'll leave the church early in the morning, driving 2.5hrs to Damascus. Then the trail will take around 3-4 hours to ride. Then the return drive home.
- The price for shuttle service and bike rental is approximately \$39 (plus tax) per person.
 - ⇒ The church is providing funding for our Youth under 18 to help cover the cost for them. Depending on how many sign-up it should cover all or most of this fee.
- Everyone will need to pack a lunch for eating on the trail. Bring a backpack to carry food and drinks.
- A sign-up sheet will be in the lobby at church.
