In John 16:4, Jesus says to the apostles that he had not told them everything right at the very beginning. That was probably a wise strategy on our Lord's part, don't you think? Imagine if he had told them everything that he had planned for them right at the very beginning. Do you think any of them would have signed up for it?

In the last few sentences that came before him telling them that he hadn't shared everything with them up front, Jesus had told them that a day would come when anyone who killed them would think that they were offering service to God. People would kill them and think that was the right thing to do! And sure enough, that's what happened.

According to church tradition, only the apostle John lived into old age and died of old age. James was beheaded at Herod's order. Andrew was crucified on an X shaped cross, taking days to die, and is reported to have preached while dying. Peter was crucified upside down. Philip was hanged. Bartholomew was flayed, like what you do to a fish when you clean it. And on and on it like this. To all of them.

Who would agree to live in a way that was likely to end like that? Who would keep doing it when it turned ugly?

The answer to both of those questions is people who knew Jesus. When a person meets Jesus, and when they really get to know him, then they realize that being loved by him is worth more than breathing. What Jesus has to offer is so excellent that life in this broken world pales away and vanishes in significance by comparison.

Jesus offers us life. Real, true life. What we have known in this world is only an echo of that. We've lived our lives marked by sin, suffering, and sorrow. Even the life of a follower of Jesus is impacted by these things. What Jesus offers is life set free from all of that. The power of Jesus resurrection is at work in his followers even now, and we have hope for a future that is beyond imagining.

And the wonder of Jesus resurrection is a promise that the life he offers is a life beyond the reach of death. Those who follow him pass through death an into life. We die with him in baptism, and are raise with him into his way of life, something that we can never lose. Then, even if our bodies die, we know that death cannot hold us. Like Jesus, we are free.

Now before Jesus had gone through the cross and resurrection, who would be willing to bet his life on the possibility that Jesus could give us life beyond death? If he had told them this was his plans for them from the start, I suspect they would have run away in terror.

But not us. We have the the whole plan from the beginning. It's safe for us to know that this might be part of what happens, because we also know that death ultimately cannot touch us. With our mighty King, Christ Jesus, we have passed from death to life and have overcome.
