Jesus's very first miracle was instigated by his mother. Who knows what he might have done if Mary hadn't pushed her son by saying to him, "They have no wine," then turning to the servants and saying, "Do whatever he tells you." Perhaps Jesus had a plan for how he would have introduced himself to the world as a miracle-working Messiah. His brief moment of resistance to Mary has always suggested to me that he did, and the way that Jesus was so intentional about everything he did tells me he had a plan of some kind. But somehow his mother knew he could solve the problem, and she made clear to him that he had to do it.

So he did. Even the Son of God honored his mother.

Lately, the story of the wedding in Cana keeps coming to my mind for some reason. Perhaps it's because two young women who are precious to the life of this church are getting married this month, one this very day. The story keeps coming to my mind in my prayers for these two daughters of this church, as I think about how I want Jesus to bless these new families the way he blessed the family in Cana. I want him to intervene for them when trouble looms before them. To clear the way for their joy and preserve them from shame. What he did so long ago for the couple in trouble at their wedding, I want him to do for these two precious brides and their grooms.

But this morning, the story comes to mind for a different reason. Jesus showed his followers how he honored his mother. She was important to him. Even though his ministry would call him away from her, and at least at one point would put him at odds with her, he loved her. He treated her with respect and submitted his will to her. A person could spend years unpacking that idea - that the King of Heaven's armies bent his will to a human woman, changing his intended work in his mission to fit her perception of the needs of the moment. The idea that God should submit his will to anyone at all is a pretty strange one, but there he is doing what she asks him to do.

For now, though, just notice that your King did this. The reason the story comes to mind on this particular Sunday, of course, is that today is Mother's Day. Jesus has given us an example: as he honored his mother, so we should honor ours.

For my mother, Anne Bailey, I cannot alter my plans of showing the world that I can work miracles, because to my knowledge I cannot. What I can do to follow the example of Jesus to make sure she knows that I love her.

Your Lord honored his mother. If you are a follower of Jesus, make sure that you do that too. Happy Mother's Day.
