



A BRIEF WORD FROM THE PASTOR:

"Hello everyone! I want to thank you all for the warm welcome you gave me. I look forward to getting to know each of you better.

I grew up on my family's dairy farm in rural Western Pennsylvania. I was raised in the Church of God in Clarion, PA. I have two younger brothers who are both married and have children of their own. As a result, I have a total of six nephews and nieces. At the age of nine, I prayed to receive Jesus as my Lord and Savior in Children's Church. Also that summer, after my first experience at church camp, I was baptized outdoors at Whitehall Camp. Following the Lord's direction, I worked as a high school substitute teacher in PA and as a missionary in Spain. After this I served as a chaplain in a hospital for two years. Then, I was the pastor of a Church of God congregation in rural Western PA for five years. Most recently, I have worked as a wheelchair van driver for Community Ambulance Service in PA from 2020-2023.

The following is the message that I believe God wants me to share with you. "Taste and see that the LORD is good" (Ps. 34:8). Read the Bible. By reading God's Word, the Bible, we grow in our relationship with Jesus and nourish our soul. We come to know the heart of God, God's will for our life, and the mind of Christ. God loves us and has a perfect plan for your life and mine. But how will we ever fully discover it, if we are not daily reading the Scriptures and applying them? The Word of God is living and active, and, if we let it, the Bible will transform us to make us more like Jesus. It starts with us getting into the habit of daily reading the Bible.

If you have never read the Bible from cover to cover, I encourage you to first read each book in the New Testament of the Bible. After finishing every book in the New Testament, then start reading every book in the Old Testament. If this feels like an impossible task, just read one chapter a day and let it soak in. Every book in the Bible is a love letter from God to you and direction for your life. Get a Bible that is easy to read and understand. If you have never read the Bible before, I recommend reading the New Living Translation of the Bible (NLT). Whether it is pages in a book or on your smartphone, start reading a chapter a day, and you will be blessed by the living God. Read your Bible.

I want to thank God for his Word, the Holy Spirit, and my Christian family and friends, whom God has used to make me the Christ-follower I am today. I also thank God for all of you and look forward to everything Jesus will do through us, as we work together in the Body of Christ.
