A BRIEF WORD FROM THE PASTOR:

We are in the season of Lent – forty days of reflection leading up to the celebration of the Resurrection of our Lord. It is a season in which we hear Jesus once again say, "Follow me." We, then, are called to consider three things in light of these words:

- A) Who are we invited to follow?
- B) What is our response to the invitation?
- C) What impact does this invitation have on our lives?

In Mark 1:14-20, we find Jesus walking along the shoreline of the Sea of Galilee and hear him call out, first to one set of brothers and then to another set, all fishermen, "Follow me." These practical, family men "at once ... without delay" left their nets (the source of their income) and their father (their family) "and followed him." They would learn along the Way what this "following Jesus" would mean and it transformed them, individually, and their obedience transformed the world. *(continued on page 2)*

I invite you to consider the impact of your response to this call to follow Him. Has it changed anything? Has it changed everything?

This time of introspection and reflection then leads us, with tears of sorrow and of gratitude, to the cross of Good Friday. This day is "good" because of Love – love that pursued and so loved us that Love went to the cross in our place. Amazing grace! Then, we are enabled to rise on Easter Sunday morning with our joy renewed as we rejoice again in His Resurrection and the power of His Life in our lives.

Will you join us for Sunday morning services at 9:30 am, followed by Sunday school, and then also for Holy Week services, beginning with Palm Sunday, April 2, at 9:30 am. We will then participate in Maundy Thursday service at 6:00 pm and Easter Sunday, Sunrise service at 7:00 am followed by breakfast and our regular worship service at 9:30 am with Sunday school following. Zion Community Church of God recently connected with the Iowa State Assembly of the Churches of God for an important meeting regarding technology and having a greater online presence.

Part of that meeting revolved around making sure all of the Iowa Church of God churches have a POWERFUL, IMPACTFUL, INFLUENTIAL ONLINE PRESENCE. To go along with that desire, there was the notification and intent to utilize state funds to help all the churches get the equipment, technology and training assistance necessary to be able to live-stream services, have an active and engaging website, and greater connect with their communities and the world. Some churches have a head start and may only need a portion of the help to achieve this goal.

Zion is already streaming services, but did not have a website. That has changed! With the funds that were available to us, we have chosen a couple of new platforms to utilize in creating our website and built-in streaming location at zero cost to Zion for the first year. We have also installed a newer camera with an auto-tracking feature that will help follow particular speakers that like to move about the worship area. A new church computer will also be made available for volunteers to utilize in various tasks required to facilitate the ministry needs of our church.
