

Community Opportunities:

-Homework Helpers happens on Mond afternoons during the regular school months for students in public, private, chomeschools. Caring volunteers work with students on their assignments (including virtual assignments) and encourage them to try hard and do the best. We have 4 new laptops donated a community organization as well as 6 older desktop computers available for student use.

-Camp Antioch Library is open every Monday and other days as needed for stude and adults to check out classic and modern books that are appropriate and acceptable for Christian reading. In August a number of local homeschoolers held "Literature Fair" which was a lot of fun!

-CPR/Basic Lifesaving Classes are now being offered for people ages 15 years an older! Certified instructors led a class on September 24th and will offer more class throughout the year. These classes are a great opportunity for people in your chur to get this training. The cost is \$40 to cover the manual and the official "certification" (instructors are volunteers). PRAY FOR THE MIDDLE EAST


The intense conflict in the Middle East is a reason for Christians to pray. Thousands people have been killed since Hamas attacked Israel on Oct. 7.
