

Greetings to all! I just want to acknowledge my gratitude for Francine Korn as well as Denise Britton who spear headed the celebration of my 25th Anniversary of my Ordination. It was the first time in my priesthood that it was celebrated, I am deeply moved by your support and comments as well as your joy in my priesthood. Today's reading is about beginnings and endings. Today we hear the beginning of the Acts of the Apostles and the conclusion of the Gospel of Mark. Both readings refer to the same moment, though: the ascension of Jesus, the conclusion of one part of the apostles' journey and relationship with Jesus and at the very same moment, the start of a new chapter in the journey --- an ending and a beginning together as is often the case.

Once we encounter Christ alive in our hearts, in our relationships, and in our world, we are also called to give away what we have been given. It is the only way the story can continue, our story and the Christian story. We give the fits that were given to us, and we find fulfillment. It is the way of Jesus.

It is the way of the apostles. St. Paul offers us guidance and insight into how we follow this way and transmit the good news, not only in words but in the witness of our lives.

He challenges us to live up to the call by cultivating gentleness, humility, and compassion in all we do. We learn a new way of being in relationship with one another, a way that seeks unity and fellowship, not competition, rivalry, and superiority. The way of Jesus that we are called to embody and demonstrate to the world is a new beginning, a way of generosity and peace, a way that stands in contrast to the values of the world. When we surrender our lives and choose to follow this way, we allow Jesus to live in us. We become an extension of the Body of Christ in the World. One way of life ends as a new way begins. The invitation to this new beginning is offered to us today; all we need to do is claim it.
