PASTOR'S CORNER

March 2022 Epiphany Lutheran Church

"Celebrating The Cross and Resurrection"

The central event of the Christian faith is the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. "That unitive event of cross and resurrection is the core of the apostolic preaching; it is also the central celebration of the church's liturgy." ¹



Ash Wednesday is considered the Day of Atonement. March 2, 2022, we begin a journey through Lent. It begins a penitential discipline which leads us to Maundy Thursday where we hear absolution and peace in the liturgy.

This year on Transfiguration Sunday, we will embrace the pleasant medieval custom of the farewell to Alleluia. A banner will be made with the word "Alleluia" and it will be processed out of the sanctuary as a symbol of putting away Alleluia until the feast of the Resurrection. I'm not sure if you've ever experienced this symbolism in the liturgy before but I hope that you will embrace the Alleluia of the heart so that you may find that joy and satisfaction on the day of the Resurrection. I am hoping to do an activity with the children's message to teach them the importance of Lent for the Christian heart.

I hope that all of you will attend **Ash Wednesday service on 3/2/2022 at 7:00 PM**. At the worship service, you will receive ashes as the extraordinary rich symbol of our faith and Christian practices. "Ashes in a Jewish and Christian context suggest judgment and God's condemnation of sin; frailty, our total dependence upon God for life; and repentance. We are reminded forcefully of the words of the committal in the burial service, earth to earth, ashes to ashes, dust to dust."²

The Social Ministry Committee met via Zoom on Wednesday, February 2, 2022. Current News!



Manna Food Bank – Mission Sunday was February 13, 2022. We collected 310 pounds of food! There was a sign inside the Synagogue every Sunday to remind the congregation of the Mission Sunday date and we will continue to do so. We will have a sign-up sheet passed around the congregation on Sundays for volunteers to offer to deliver the donations to Manna Food Bank. Gerry will be in charge of making sure volunteers have their cars parked by the entrance on the right side of the Synagogue, by 8:00 am on their volunteered day. We have volunteers

so far as follows: Judith for February, Carole for March, and Gerry for April. The address to deliver is: 3030 N. E Street, Pensacola, FL 32501. Just pull around to the back on the left side of the building, back your vehicle into the driveway, ring the doorbell and someone will come to help unload your trunk. Please sign up to deliver! We need your help! Don't forget to take photos, get the slip stating the pounds donated and email those to Regina.

Note: PLEASE DO NOT BRING ANY FOOD ITEMS INSIDE THE BRIT AHM MESSIANIC SYNAGOGUE. ALSO, DO NOT LEAVE ANY FOOD ITEMS OUTSIDE THE SYNAGOGUE. This is a trunk-to-trunk process.

Ronald McDonald House **Pull Tab Collections** – This is a joint effort with the members of the Synagogue. Both congregations

donate into the collection box by the window in the fellowship room by the windows. Barb will be responsible for the delivery of those each month or when it gets full.

Eyeglasses for Lions Club – This is also a joint effort with the members of the Synagogue. Both congregations will donate into the collection box also by the window in the fellowship

hall by the windows. **Barb will also be in charge of the delivery of those each month or when it gets full.** The Lions Club Eyeglass donation box was full! and 22 pairs of eyeglasses were delivered to the local Lions Club office. Lion Club members inspect the glasses, determine the prescription, and clean the eyewear so it can be used again. These glasses will then get matched with someone who needs them anywhere around the world. Many are used in medical missions to other countries.

Save **eyeglasses** for the Lion's Club. Collection containers for these items are located in the fellowship hall by the windows in the back of the room. They are labeled with Epiphany Lutheran Church.

Brit Ahm Synagogue clothes swap/ Clothing Drive – This will be a joint effort. Both congregations will donate. Clothing items need to be clean with no stains. They are to be folded and placed on the back pews for collection. The schedule is as follows: February 26, June 11, September 17, and December 10, 2022. These are Saturdays, which is when the Synagogue has their service. The clothes swap begins at 1 p.m. on these dates. We could start bringing in the donations the Sunday before beginning with the June date. For example, our donations can come in on Sunday, June 5, September 11, and December 4, 2022. All remaining items that people cannot use will be donated to the homeless. We are invited to join the Synagogue with the delivery of items. Anyone interested in helping to deliver can contact Jerri with the synagogue. Please ask Regina or the church office for email contact information.

Brit Ahm Synagogue Feeding the Homeless – The homeless folks currently living under the I-10 bridge have relocated. There will be 2 groups of approximately 40 persons in each group. Jerri with the Synagogue holds a get together at her home every Monday evening. Anyone that would like to join them for soup and prepare sack lunches can email Jerri. Space is limited each week.

Jerri is also in charge of delivering the sack lunches, clothing etc, to the homeless. She invites us to volunteer to meet them somewhere or just show up where the homeless are: The deliveries will be on Tuesdays at 11:00am, and usually only takes about 30 minutes. Anyone interested in deliveries or locations to meet can contact Jerri. Jerri brought up the fact that at the new homeless shelters, the residents will have places for gardens. The residents will also have kitchens. Sometime in the future the Synagogue may be taking donations for gardening tools, plant sprouts, planting soil, and kitchen items. More to come on that.

Due to Bible Study being held on Wednesdays, the next regular meeting of the Social Ministry Committee will take place on Monday, March 7, 2022, at 6 pm via Zoom
