This is how the birth of Jesus Christ came about: His mother Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be with child through the Holy Spirit.

Matthew 1:18

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ,

We are in the season of Advent as we prepare to celebrate the birth of God's only Son. Scripture teaches us that God loves us so much that he gifted us a Savior.
