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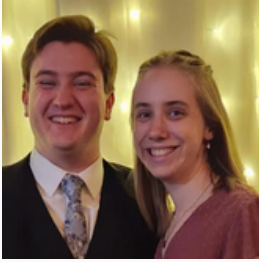
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New Faces at PC

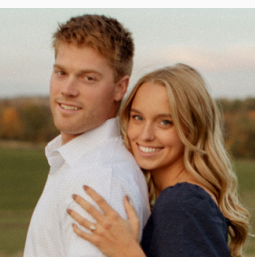
Mr. Steve Kaisand - PCHS Math

Pella Christian Board of Trustees Update

On July 1, 2024 Pella Christian officially became one legal entity governed by a single Board of Trustees. These individual Trustees were named as part of the merger vote. The first board meetings, an orientation and strategic planning session (pictured above), were held on July 22 and 23 at the Stillwaters Cabin in Oskaloosa. Starting in August, the board will meet monthly, alternating meeting locations between the grade school and the high school. The Nominations Committee, which will select the next group of incoming board trustees, met on June 18 and is planning an information session for prospective trustees on September 12. The Lord has richly blessed Pella Christian with years of wise leadership. We ask for your prayers as we seek out the Lord's leading in developing and refining our next strategic initiatives.

Enrollment Snapshot

We praise God for his faithfulness in bringing over 120 new preschool to high school students to Pella Christian Schools for the upcoming school year. This brings Pella Christian's total enrollment to over 875 students who will be living and learning in God's Story - an increase of over 40 students from the 23/24 school year and over 100 students from 22/23 school year.

The increased growth is a blessing and planning for it included a recent delivery of over 100 new desks in our elementary classes. Kindergarten to 5th grade classes have grown to 3 sections per grade level!

Pella Christian Grade School's Building and Grounds Committee has also been busy supporting the increased enrollment and creating more group meeting areas and expanding the parking lot to create a better pick up and drop off process for families.

Pella Christian High School anticipates 300 students and has focused heavily on supporting this growth through hiring additional math, science and language arts teachers.

We praise God for the students at Pella Christian Schools. Please join us in prayer as we educate and nurture His children!

We Ask for Your Continued Support

Our Christian schools depend on financial support to continue operating. We've never charged the full cost of education to families. We've always reduced tuition through thrift, volunteer labor, and financial donations from supporters. This is how we balance the budget, pay our staff, and maintain our buildings. The gap between tuition charged and the cost of education must be bridged.

In 2024/2025, the combined budgets of Pella Christian Grade School and Pella Christian High School include over \$1.2 million in expected giving. This includes direct donations from supporters, fund drives of various sorts, and budgeted withdrawals off of earnings from schools' endowments.

We plan to dedicate the last section of every Pella Christian Eagle Eye as an update to our annual fund giving. This will replace the Grade School's Quarterly Offering Letters. We'll share our progress on our yearly goal, upcoming exceptional needs, and gratitude for the gifts God has given through His people.
