Study Guide

Introductory Discussion

(10 minutes)

This week check-in with your people of peace... have you identified someone? Are you praying for someone? Has anyone 'crossed the chicken line' and asked someone to read the Bible? Have you got another gospel sharing story to share?

Discuss the Text

(10 minutes)

John. 4.4-30, 39-42

Prior to watching the video, ask two or three people in the group to read the passage in a different translation. Some translations to consider (these are available in the YouVersion Bible app or other apps, or use your own hardcopy Bibles):

ESV (English Standard Version) or LSB (Legacy Standard Bible)

CSB (Christian Standard Bible) or NIV (New International Version)

NLT (New Living Translation) or **GNB** (Good News Bible)

Then discuss the following:

- As a group, retell the story without looking at the text.
- Is there anything you don't understand? (See if the group has any wisdom)
- Does anything stand out to you?
- When do you think it's appropriate to break social morés for the sake of the gospel? Or when is it not?
- What can we learn from this passage about following Jesus today?
