Reflections

With all the passion of which I am capable, I urge you to consider the situation. The life of Adam is precarious in the extreme. We are threatened at every turn by disease, crime, loss, accident, intrusion, insanity, and terror, what is even worse, we are threatened by condemnation—exposure of what we really are, rejection by those whose love we most need, ultimate abandonment by God Himself. Humanly speaking, this is our inheritance.

Only one. That one man, Jesus Christ—He only is able to redeem us for a life free from the dominion of Sin and Death. In Him alone, in that one man alone, is joy, peace, deliverance, and a safe homecoming. In Him only. In him alone. *That one man*.
